Sunstruck's pedigree is a brew of absolute standout animals from the Millah Murrah herd.

On the maternal side, Flower N30 is the highest-valued female in Australian Angus history. The dam of Quartz Q29, Flower is structurally and phenotypically flawless and acknowledged by breeder Ross Thompson as one of the three best cows to come out of the Millah Murrah programme in 54 years.

On the paternal side, is Nectar, whose dam, Prue H113, is the first cow in the Australian Angus herd to produce three sons at \$40,000 or better. Nectar is the cornerstone behind recent generations of Heart Angus stud.

His progeny has achieved many sale highlights, including the \$160,000 high selling bull at Millah Murrah's world record averaging bull sale of 2022, when Sugar Ray S76 was purchased by Ascot and Clift Angus.

Pedigrees do not come deeper.


Structurally, Sunstruck walks on flawless feet and legs. He has a tremendous sire's outlook, strong jaw and muzzle. His reproductive anatomy is perfect. And phenotypically, Sunstruck is a super dense, easy fleshing animal. Born at 41kg, he weighed 954kg aged 25 months, in a flat frame score 6, with 44cm testes.

Nectar's dam, Prue H113

The package is complete when the EBV data is considered. Few bulls can match Sunstruck's predictions for completeness and sheer balance across the entire suite of traits.

With no sign of Northern hemisphere genetics for at least three generations, Sunstruck is a tremendous representative of the Antipodean Angus herd and a bull that demands widespread application, in stud and commercial programmes, right across the globe.
